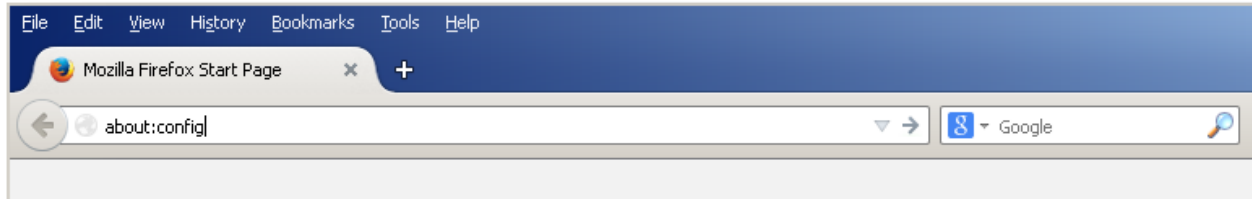


## Instructions for Downloading Audio Files from Saint Joseph Radio in FireFox

- 1.) Open FireFox
- 2.) Enter **about:config** into the location bar and press the **Enter key**.



- 3.) Click on the **I'll be careful, I promise!** button.




- 4.) Enter **media.directshow.enabled** into the search field.
